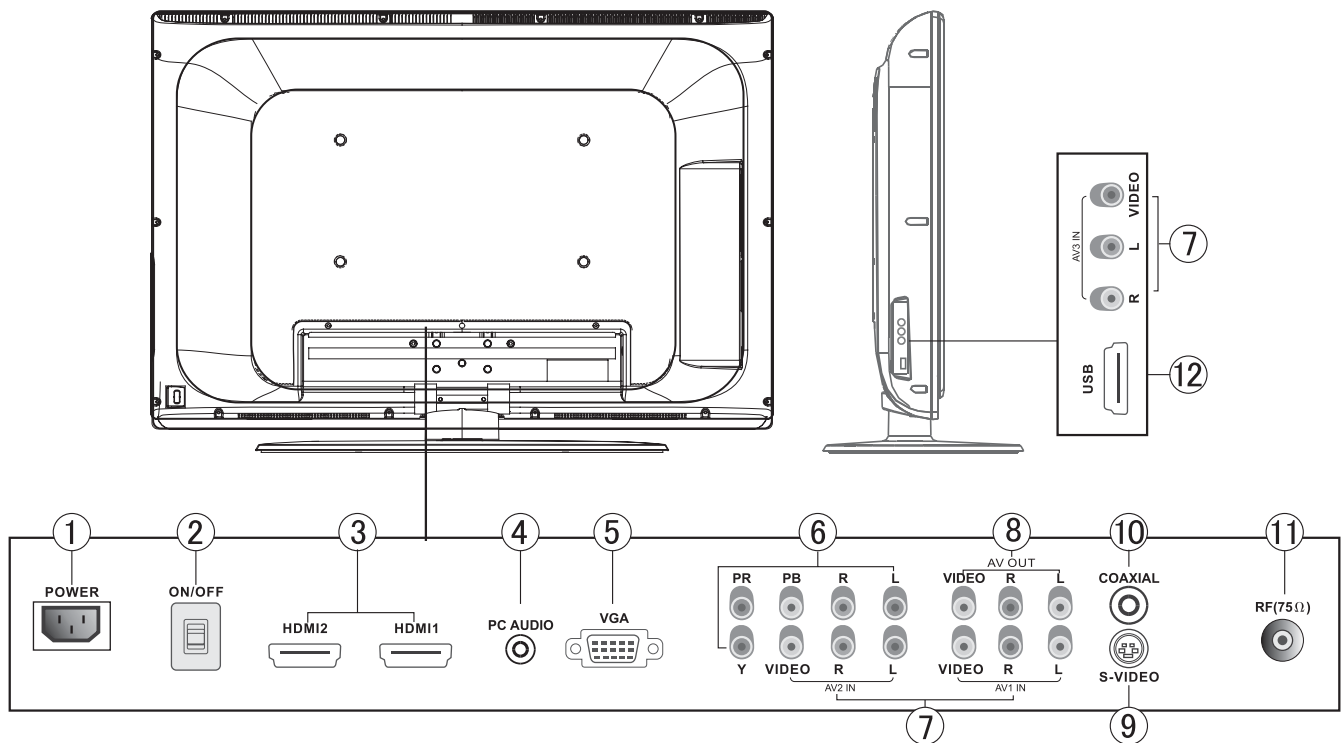

# LCD TV

## Remote control



- \* If there is a light around the TV , the remote control may not work properly.
- \* Remove the batteries from the remote control if it is not going to be used for an extended period of time



## Application instruction of remote control

**POWER:** Power on/off button; press once to turn the TV on and press again to turn the TV off.

**I/II:** Press the I/II button to choose a different audio channel.

**SLEEP:** Scheduled power off time button, which allows the customer to set the TV power off time according to the preset times displayed.

**MUTE:** Mute button, press once to disable the speaker and press again to enable the speaker.

**ASPECT:** Picture size scale button, which allows the customer to scale the picture between different sizes.

**P.MODE :** Picture mode button of TV, which allows customer to select different picture modes.

**S.MODE :** Sound mode button of TV, which allows customer to select different sound modes.

**INFO:** Display the information of current source.

**SOURCE:** Signal source selection button, which allows the user to select the signal source input (DTV/ATV/AV1/ AV2 /AV3/S-VIDEO/YPBPR/PC/HDMI1/HDMI2/USB).

**MENU:** Press to display the OSD menu or return up menu.

**EXIT:** To return to the screen.

**Volume (VOL) +/-:** Volume up and down button, which allows the customer to increase or decrease the volume.

**Channel(CH) +/-:** Channel up and down button, which allows the customer to increase or decrease the channel.

**OK:** To confirm the choice with the highlighted menu item. To display the channel list in the no-menu state.

**0,1~9:** TV channel selection button, which allows the customer to select the channel.

**ATV/DTV:** Switch button which allows the user to switch ATV/DTV.

 : Channel revert button of TV, which allows the customer to watch the last TV channel.

**CH.LIST:** Which allows to list all program.

**FAV:** Press the FAV to start the "Favourite List" to select your favourite program.

**EPG:** To show the Electronic Program Guide.

**TV/RADIO:** Switch between the TV service and Radio.

**SUBTITLE:** Press the Subtitle to enable/disable subtitle.

## Teletext operation

**TTX:** Press TTX to enter teletext state and display teletext page.If want to display image and teletext page at the same time, press this button again. If want to exit teletext state, press this button again. When teletext page is displayed on the screen, you can select relevant function by using the remote control.

**SUBPAGE:** Is refer to the subpage of teletext page, i.e. subcode page. When it is pressed, the screen display the requirement of subpage code entry. If there is no subpage, it will not be displayed. In most case, there is no subpage.

**HOLD:** Press it once to keep the display of the page, and press it again to exit hold state.

**CANCEL:** Do not display the content of the page, but only the channel image. Press it again to display the content of the page again. or button on the remote control can be used to display the content of previous or next page.Number buttons on the remote control can be used to get to a certain page. Press the red, green, blue and yellow button on the remote control, the page of relevant color displayed on the lower part of the screen will be displayed.

**SIZE:** Press it once to enlarge the content on the upper part of the page, and press it the second time to enlarge the content on the lower part of the page, and the third time to resume normal display of all the contents on the page.

**REVEAL:** Press it once to display the hide text, press it again to close the display of hide text.

**INDEX:** Press it once to display the index for all the teletext page.

**FAST TEXT (For possible future reference):**The RED, GREEN, YELLOW & BLUE buttons are used for quick access to color coded pages transmitted by FAST TEXT broadcast.

**Example:** RED selects CITY INFORMATION, BLUE selects TRAVEL INFORMATION, GREEN selects WEATHERINFORMATION, YELLOW selects TV PROGRAMMING.

▶II: Play/Pause the selection. On the PICTURE or MOVIE mode, cut the small window into full-screen playback.

■ : When playing USB, press STOP once, the unit will memorize the previous ending point.

▶▶ : Press the ▶▶ button for quick forward search.

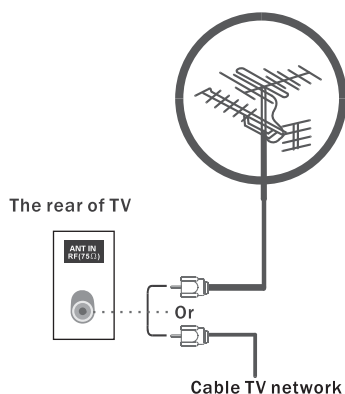
◀◀ : Press the ◀◀ button for quick rewind search.

▶▶ : When playing a USB, press NEXT to play the next chapter .

◀◀ : When playing a USB, press PREV to play the previous chapter.

**REPEAT:** When playing a USB, press the REPEAT button continually, the TV screen will show in sequence: repeat1, repeat all, repeat off.

## Connecting to antenna or radio network



In order to receive TV programmes, a signal needs to be received from one of the following signal sources:

- ◆ Outdoor antenna.
- ◆ Cable TV network.
- ◆ Satellite broadcast network

1. In these three cases, the input cable of antenna or TV network should be plugged in the 75 Ohm coaxial cable jack at the rear side of LCD TV.

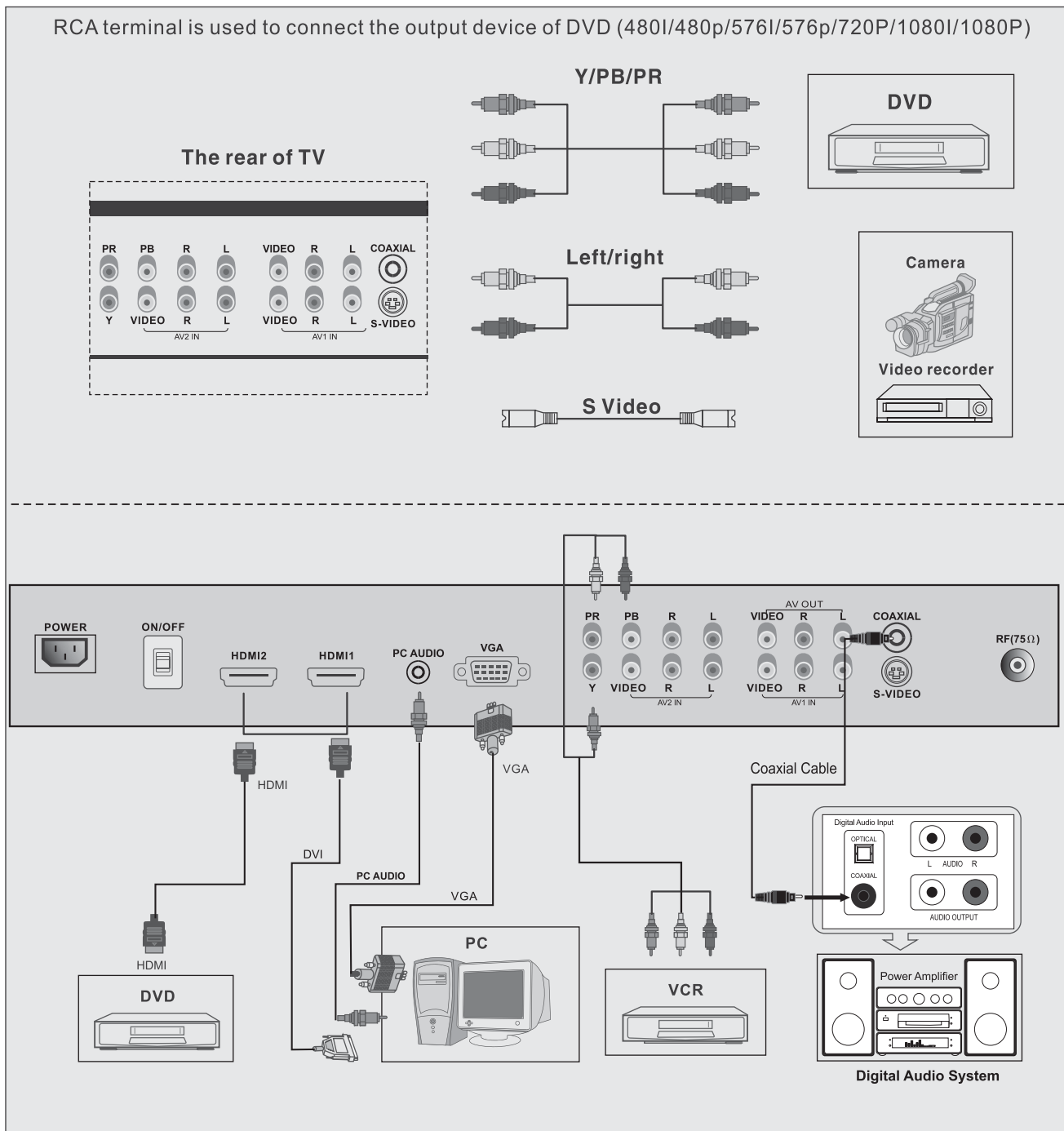
2. Indoor antenna is NOT recommended for this TV.

When installing LCD TV, qualified 75 Ohm coaxial Cable must be used. If other coaxial cable is used, there may be noise and image disturbances.

# LCD TV

## Connecting to exterior devices

RCA terminal is used to connect the output device of DVD (480I/480p/576I/576p/720P/1080I/1080P)



### Notices:

1. AV1/ S-Video use a common Audio (R1, L1).
2. Y-PB-PR of DVD is corresponding to Y-PB-PR of the TV.
3. DVI to HDMI and using the PC audio.
4. PC to VGA also using the PC audio.
5. AV IN and Y-PB-PR signal are from the DVD.
6. Coaxial signal output to Digital Audio System. (Support Coaxial decoder)

## PROGRAMME EDIT



Press ► button to enter Programme Edit menu.

### Delete

Press ▲/▼ button to select the channel you want to delete, then press DELETE(RED)button, and the channel will be marked DELETE, press DELETE(RED)button again to delete, Press MENU button to cancel.

### Rename(only ATV)

Press ▲/▼ button to select the channel you want to rename, press RENAME(GREEN)button, the channel will be marked RENAME, then press ▲/▼button to select the position of word, press ◀/▶button to select the letter you want.

### Swap

Press ▲/▼ button to select the channel you want to swap, then press SWAP (YELLOW), and the channel will be swap.

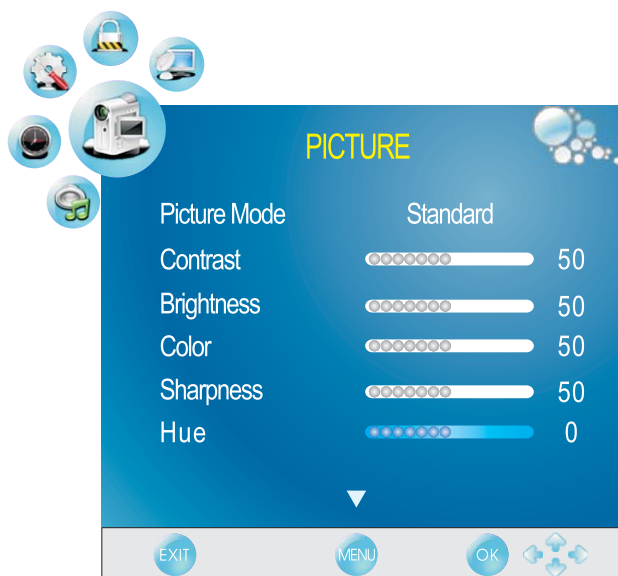
### Skip

Press ▲/▼ button to select the channel you want to skip, then press SKIP(BLUE) to mark or disarm the channel. The channel marked SKIP will be skipped when you scan channels with CH+/CH- button.

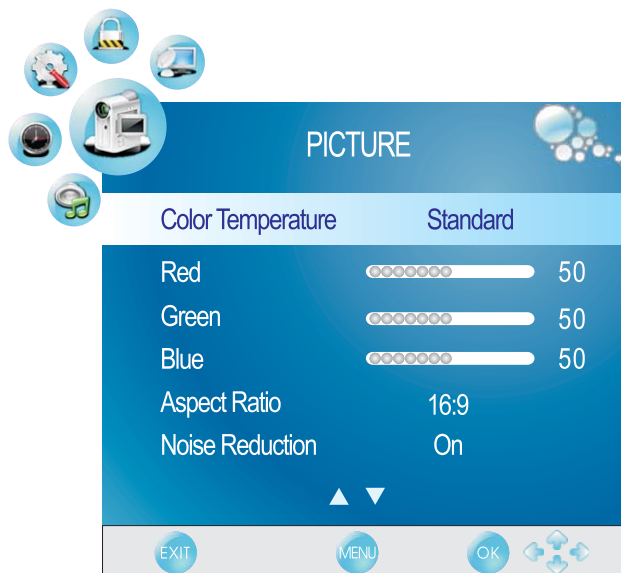

2) Press OK button to play the selection in the small window, then press ▶|| button to cut into full-screen.

3) In the full-screen playback state, press ▶|| button to play or pause picture, press MENU button don't show TV\_MENU. Press EXIT button to quit full-screen.



### MUSIC

1) Press OK button to the submenu.  
Press ▲/▼ button to select the file.  
Press ◀/▶ button to the last or next menu.

2) Press OK or ▶|| button to play the selection.  
Press ■ or EXIT button to quit playing state.

3) In the full-screen playback state, Press ◀◀/▶▶ button to achieve the corresponding functions. ◀◀/▶▶ button don't work. Press EXIT button to quit full-screen.

## Trouble shooting

Before contacting the service technician, perform the following simple checks. If any problem still persists, unplug the LCD TV and call for assistance.

No sound and picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Check that the main plug has been connected to a wall let.</li> <li>- Check that you have pressed the POWER button on the front of TV set.</li> <li>- Check the picture contrast and brightness settings.</li> </ul>
Normal picture but no sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Check the volume.</li> <li>- Sound muted? Press the MUTE button.</li> <li>- Try another channel the problem may be with the broadcast.</li> <li>- Are the audio cables installed properly.</li> </ul>
The remote control does not work	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Check to see if there any object between the product and remote control Causing obstruction.</li> <li>- Are batteries installed with correct polarity(+ to +,- to -).</li> <li>- Correct remote operating mode set: TV, VCR etc.?</li> <li>- Install new batteries</li> </ul>
Power is suddenly turned off	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Is the sleep timer set.</li> <li>- Check the power control settings. Power interrupted.</li> <li>- No broadcast on station tuned with auto activated.</li> </ul>
Picture appears slowly after switching on	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- This is normal, the image is muted during the product startup process. Please contact your service center, if the picture has not appeared after five minutes.</li> </ul>
No or poor color or poor picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Adjust the color in menu option.</li> <li>- Keep a sufficient distance between the product and the VCR.</li> <li>- Try another channel, the problem may be with the broadcast.</li> <li>- Are the VIDEO cables installed properly?</li> <li>- Activate the any function to restore the brightness of the picture.</li> </ul>
Horizontal/vertical bars or picture shaking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Check for local interference such as an electrical appliance or power tool.</li> </ul>
Poor reception on some channels	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Station or cable product experiencing problems. Tune to another station.</li> <li>- Station signal is weak, reorient antenna to receive weaker station.</li> <li>- Check for sources of possible interference.</li> </ul>
Lines or streaks in pictures	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Check the antenna(Change the direction of the antenna).</li> </ul>
No output from one of the speakes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Adjust balance in menu option.</li> </ul>

**NOTE:** There is a problem in VGA mode.(Only VGA mode applied)

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE SOLUTION
The signal is out of range.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Adjust resolution, horizontal frequency, or vertical frequency.</li><li>- Check it whether the signal cable is connected or loose.</li><li>- Check the input source.</li></ul>
Vertical bar or stripe on back ground&Horizontal Noise&Incorrect position.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Work the auto configure or adjust clock, phase, or H/V position.</li></ul>
Screen color is unstable or single color.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Check the signal cable.</li><li>- Reinstall the PC video card.</li></ul>

## Maintenance

Early malfunctions can be prevented. Careful and regular cleaning can extend the amount of time you will have your new TV. Be sure to turn the power off and unplug the power cord before you begin any cleaning.

### Cleaning the screen

1. Here's a great way to keep the dust off your screen for a while. Wet a soft cloth in a mixture of lukewarm water and a little fabric softener or dish washing detergent. Wring the cloth until it's almost dry, and then used it to wipe the screen.
2. Make sure the excess water is off the screen, and then let it air-dry before you turn on your TV.

### Cleaning the cabinet

To remove dirt or dust, wipe the cabinet with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Please be sure not to use a wet cloth.

### Extended Absence



If you expect to leave your TV dormant for a long time(such as a vacation), it's a good idea to unplug the power cord to protect against possible damage from lightning or power surges.
